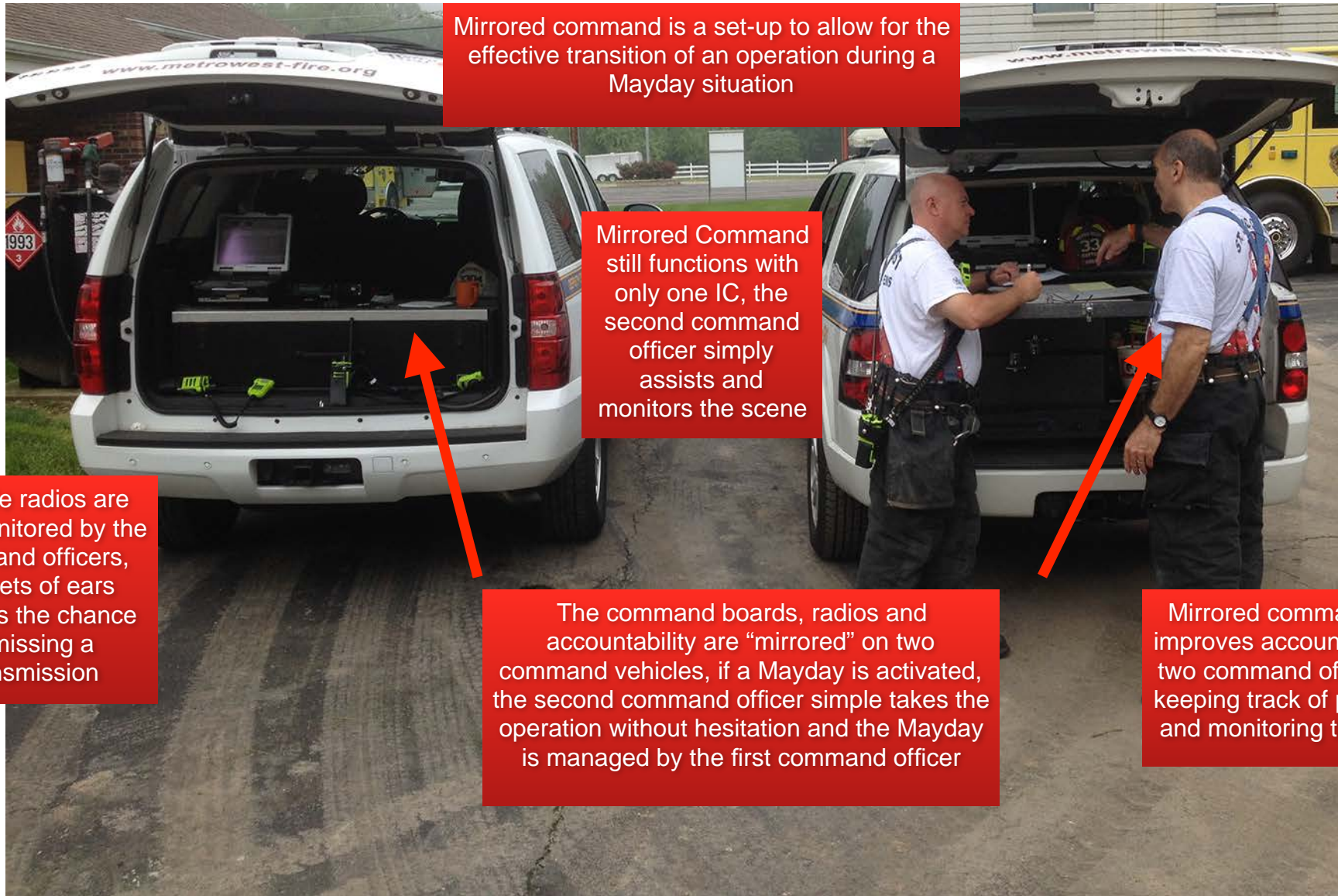


Back to Basics

Mirrored Command



Mirrored command is a set-up to allow for the effective transition of an operation during a Mayday situation

Mirrored Command still functions with only one IC, the second command officer simply assists and monitors the scene

Multiple radios are also monitored by the command officers, two sets of ears reduces the chance of missing a transmission

The command boards, radios and accountability are "mirrored" on two command vehicles, if a Mayday is activated, the second command officer simple takes the operation without hesitation and the Mayday is managed by the first command officer

Mirrored command also improves accountability as two command officers are keeping track of personnel and monitoring the scene
